Responsibilities:

- Manages Phase 1, 2 and 3
 - o Conducts thorough assessments of all inpatients and outpatients referred to cardiac rehabilitation services and assesses appropriately for participation in therapies
 - o Coordinates and communicates care among hospital health care disciplines/professionals
 - o Develops appropriate and comprehensive treatment plans specific to patient needs, including education, exercise, ambulation, and counseling
 - o Supervises activity, exercise, monitors responses and directs care accordingly
 - o Documents treatment in patient charts, reports noteworthy findings to appropriate health care providers
 - o Maintains accurate patient program data and assists in outcomes measurement/management
- Assists the Regional Manager of Cardiovascular Services in the development and implementation of department policies and procedures
- Assumes responsibility for communicating and implementing changes in hospital/departmental policy/procedures
- Assists in the staff development program through the provision of in-service education and clinical/technical staff support
- Assists in scheduling and triaging patient testing
- Maintains exercise facilities and equipment
- Responds to medical incidents/emergencies
- Performs necessary administrative responsibilities
